



OUR WHISKIES, BRANDIES AND LIQUEURS

SINGLE MALTS £3.50 single

Malt whisky is the original whisky of Scotland, made only from malted barley, in two or occasionally three copper pot stills, by a batch process. A single malt is the product of an individual distillery. We offer the following single malts:-

Glenfiddich

A colossus, Glenfiddich was established by William Grant in 1876, with the first spirit running off the stills in 1887. Today the company is still run by his descendants and now accounts for about 30% of all single malt sales worldwide. Its flavour profile is classic Speyside with a light, smooth texture and notes of orchard fruits, oak, and vanilla flan. The finish is coating and lightly sweet with more oak and pear.

Glenlivet

Made in the Scottish Highlands since 1824, The Glenlivet is the world's second best-selling single malt. Malt from Speyside and mineral water from Cairngorms National Park are distilled in traditional lantern-shaped stills and then matured in oak casks, giving The Glenlivet its smooth, rich and fruity flavour.

Glen Moray

Light, smooth and fruity, this is the perfect introduction to the world of single malt Scotch whisky. Encapsulating the flavours for which Glen Moray and indeed Speyside itself is loved for around the world.

Old Pulteney

The flagship of Inver House's single malt portfolio, Pulteney is one of the most northerly distilleries on the Scottish mainland. It has been producing maritime influenced Scotch since 1826. Dry, medium bodied and smooth, redolent of honey and cream, faintly salty with a slight spicy note and a sweet long-lasting finish.

BLENDED WHISKIES £2.50 SINGLE

Blended Scotch whisky is the combination of malt and grain whiskies, matured for at least three years in oak. In the early days, blending whisky was a good way of taming often fiery malts, with the lightness of the grain rounding off hard corners and softening jagged edges of flavour and alcohol, but this evolved into something far more subtle and refined, in which painstaking permutations of malt and grain eke out different characteristics in each other, producing balanced and consistent whiskies, but also whiskies of new complexity and depth. BRANDIES £3.00 single

Courvoisier

A lively blend of youthful and aged cognacs, Courvoisier VS has an intriguing balanced taste. Expect delicate flavours of spring blossoms with a hint of ripe orchard fruits such as apple and pear, with the juicy tang of grapefruit. These fruity and floral flavours lead into a smooth, fresh and oaky finish.

Three Barrells

Carefully hand crafted and aged in oak, Three Barrells VSOP, a fine old fresh brandy has a superior smooth and velvety taste with hints of almond and walnut, with a long finish of candied fruits and ginger.

Calvados

Brandy produced from fermented apples using pot stills in the Normandy region of France.

LIQUEURS £3.00 single

Drambuie

A unique golden coloured liquor made from Scotch Whisky, heather honey, herbs and spices. Reputed to be the personal elixir of Bonnie Prince Charlie, the recipe of which he gifted by way of thanks to his supporters, when he landed on the West Coast of Scotland, as part of his attempt to retake his crown.

Grand Marnier

A unique blend of French Cognac and exotic, bitter oranges, Grand Marnier has been crafted in the Cognac region of France with the same care and passion since 1880. Cordon Rouge is the original Grand Marnier, with a full and ample flavour, bitter oranges aroma balanced by Cognac notes of hazelnut and toffee.

Cointreau

Cointreau is a unique blend of sweet and bitter orange peels distilled in Angers with traditional methods to obtain a perfect and crystalline orange liqueur with the best natural orange aromas, which has not changed since its creation by Edouard Cointreau in 1875. The aroma is pure and perfumed with high pitch orange zest, pith and peel bursting with freshness

Baileys

With its distinct velvety texture, it is a perfect combination of smooth cocoa cream and Irish whisky. Enjoy on its own, over ice or in your favourite coffee.

Tia Maria

A dark coffee liqueur made originally in Jamaica using Jamaican coffee beans, but now made in Italy. The main ingredients are coffee beans, Jamaican rum, vanilla, and sugar, blended to an alcoholic content of 20%.

Kahlua

Kahlúa is a brand of coffee liqueur owned by the Pernod Ricard company and produced in Veracruz, Mexico. The drink contains rum, sugar, and arabica coffee. It is loved around the world and used in a range of drinks from coffees to cocktails.

Disaronno

This amber-coloured amaretto has a characteristic almond taste. It is an infusion of apricot oil, burnt sugar and essence of 17 selected herbs and fruits. Produced in Saronno, in the Lombardy region, it is sold worldwide as one of Italy's most popular liqueurs.

Archers Peach Schnapps

A high-quality spirit, with the crisp smooth taste of peach. Enjoy as a long drink with cranberry, orange, tonic, champagne, lemonade... or try as a cocktail. This is a blend of flavours extracted from real peaches, sugar and schnapps.

Antica Sambuca

Antica Sambuca is a sweet and natural spirit obtained from the distillation and infusion of star anise, fruits, and herbs, produced from a traditional recipe using only premium star anise blended with exceptionally smooth neutral spirit, sugar and water creating a deep rich flavour.

Jägermeister Herbal Liqueur

A delicate blend of 56 carefully selected botanicals - herbs, roots, fruits and spices. Matured in oak barrels for up to one year. 35% ABV. This German herbal liqueur is best served as an ice-cold shot. It pairs perfectly with ginger beer.

Aperol

Aperol is an Italian bittersweet apéritif liqueur made of gentian, rhubarb, and cinchona, among other ingredients. It has a vibrant orange hue and relatively low alcohol content (11%). Its name comes from the Italian slang word for aperitivo, and like other apéritifs, it is meant to stimulate the appetite.

Martini

More than just Vermouth. Indulge your inner James Bond with one of the twentieth century's most iconic drinks.

- **MARTINI Extra Dry's** rare woods, herbs, citrus and raspberry extracts are the pillar of the 20th century's defining drink: the Dry Martini cocktail. First introduced on New Year's Day 1900, after 10 years of development by Luigi Rossi's sons, MARTINI Extra Dry has at its heart the violet-scented tartness of Florentine Orris – iris roots grown for three years before being sun-dried.
- **MARTINI Bianco** dubbed the 'Bianchissimo' or the whitest, for the vanilla flowers at its heart, is a blend of herbs, flowers and white wines such as Trebbiano which come together to create a bright complex flavour.

MARTINI Rosso was the original MARTINI. When Luigi Rossi blended local botanicals to craft this scarlet-hued vermouth, he created an indisputable icon. While the exact recipe remains a closely guarded secret, this sweet vermouth's intensely herbal character is the result of blending carefully chosen wines with a complex selection of Italian herbs, including sage, savoury and dittany, and bitter-sweet exotic woods
